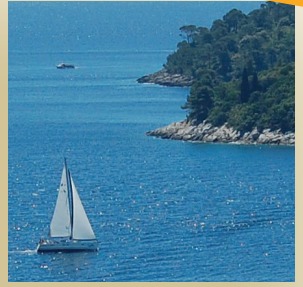


# Dubrovnik & Montenegro Flotilla



The Korčula Route sails a circular cruise from Dubrovnik Marina cruising the Elaphite Islands of Koločep, Lopud and Sipan, all with small communities and picturesque harbours on the North Western or South Eastern ends of each Island. Explore Mljet Island and the near land locked coves of Okuklje and Prozura, before sailing into the small archipelago that leads to Polace. We would recommend a visit to the scenic lakes and the monastery of St. Marija at the North Western end of Mljet before sailing on to the Idyllic historic port of Korčula.

The Montenegro Route also sets off from Dubrovnik Marina heading south to Cavtat with its picturesque waterfront promenade. An early morning start will be rewarded with spectacular views of the mountain back drop that surrounds the Bay of Kotor. From Tivat, the regional capital we set sail for the Venetian town of Kotor at the far end of the bay. Time to explore this wonderful historical town before the flotilla heads back toward Dubrovnik.

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*Travel:* Regular flights to Dubrovnik departing on Saturdays from Gatwick, and Manchester
