Located at the edge of the south-eastern Aegean, the Dodecanese Islands form a chain of twelve large islands and hundreds of smaller Islets. The cruising area is rich in history & culture, as well as offering fabulous white sandy beaches lapped by crystal clear waters. The combination of some of the better known and more cosmopolitan Greek Islands such as Kos and Kalymnos, with some of the smaller and lesser known gems of the Dodecanese such as Nysiros, Halki and Symi make this an exciting cruising area.

The Dodecanese flotilla sails two one week circular routes from Kos. Choose from the northern itinerary featuring Kalymnos and Patmos or alternatively the southern route, visiting Symi, Tilos and Nysiros before returning to Kos. This flotilla is ideally suited to the more experienced crew, as you can be virtually assured of some fresh winds each day, so you will be doing plenty of sailing.
